## Biographical / Historical

---

The Congregational Christian Woman's Fellowship of Illinois was an important institution which provided both monetary aid and personnel to local churches as well as providing aid for global missionary work. The organization's roots trace back to the Woman's Board of Missions of the Interior, founded 1868, the Illinois Branch of the Woman's Board of Missions of the Interior, founded 1878, and the Illinois Woman's Home Mission Union, founded 1886. In 1927, the Illinois Branch of the Woman's Board of Missions of the Interior and the Illinois Woman's Home Mission Union merged to

form the Congregational Woman's Missionary Society of Illinois. In 1931, following the formation of the Congregational Christian Churches denomination, the Congregational Woman's Missionary Society of Illinois changed its name to the Woman's Union of the Congregational-Christian Conferences of Illinois. In 1933, the organization changed its name one last time to the Congregational Christian Woman's Fellowship of Illinois.
